To Mu'āwiyah

أَمَّا بَعْدُ، فَإِنَّ الدُّنْيَا مَشْغَلَةٌ عَنْ غَيْرِهَا، وَلَمْ يُصَبِّ صَاحِبُهَا مِنْهَا شَيْئًا إِلَّا فَتَحَتْ لَهُ حُرُصًا عَلَيْهَا، وَلَهَجًا بِهَا، وَلَنْ يَسْتَغْنِيَ صَاحِبُهَا بِمَا نَالَ فِيهَا عَمَّا لَمْ يَبْلُغْهُ مِنْهَا، وَمِنْ وَرَاءِ ذَلِكَ فِرَاقٌ مَا جَمَعَ، وَنَقْضٌ مَا أَبْرَمَ! وَلَوْ اعْتَبَرْتَ بِمَا مَضَى حَفِظْتَ مَا بَقِيَ، وَالسَّلَامُ.
