

٢٧٧. وَقَالَ (عليه السلام): لَا وَالَّذِي أَمْسَيْنَا مِنْهُ فِي غُبْرِ لَيْلَةٍ دَهْمَاءَ تَكْشُرُ عَنْ يَوْمٍ أَغْرَّ مَا كَانَ كَذَا وَكَذَا.

277. Amīr al-mu'minīn, peace be upon him, said: I swear by Him Who let us pass the dark night after which there was a bright day that such and such [1] did not happen.
