

٤٢٩. وَقَالَ (عَلَيْهِ السَّلَامُ): إِنَّ أَعْظَمَ الْحَسِرَاتِ يَوْمَ الْقِيَامَةِ حَسْرَةُ رَجُلٍ كَسَبَ مَالًا فِي غَيْرِ طَاعَةِ اللَّهِ، فَوَرَّثَهُ رَجُلٌ فَأَنْفَقَهُ فِي طَاعَةِ اللَّهِ سَبْحَانَهُ، فَدَخَلَ بِهِ الْجَنَّةَ، وَدَخَلَ الْأَوَّلُ بِهِ النَّارَ.
