

□. وفي حديثه (عليه السلام) : إِنَّ الْإِيمَانَ يَبْدُو لُمَظَةً فِي الْقَلْبِ، كُلَّمَا أَزْدَادَ الْإِيمَانَ أَزْدَادَتِ اللَّمَظَةُ.

V. A tradition of Amīr al-mu'minīn, peace be upon him, says: Faith produces a “lumazah” in the heart. As faith develops, the “lumazah” also increases.

قال السيد الرضي: اللَّمَظَةُ مِثْلُ النَّكَتَةِ أَوْ نَحْوِهَا مِنَ الْبَيَاضِ، وَمِنْهُ قَيْلُ فَرَسٍ أَلْمَظُ: إِذَا كَانَ بِجَحْفَلَتِهِ شَيْءٌ مِنَ الْبَيَاضِ.

as-Sayyid ar-Raḍī says: “lumazah” is a white spot or something like that. On that analogy if a horse has a white spot on its lower lip it is called “farusun al-mazu”, that is, a white-spotted horse.
